

2019-2020 是一個充滿挑戰的學年,當你發現計劃趕不上轉變時,會否感到不知所措或是灰心失意呢?感恩本校繼續以「心懷信望」的態度,面對環境改變時,仍然努力尋求突破的契機,與不同持分者彼此配搭,讓學生有所成長。

自上一個學校發展周期開始,本校於初中推展「活化學習計劃」,透過學生做預習,上課摘錄筆記及進行互動討論,課後完成鞏固課業及進行學習反思等,培養積極學習的態度及建立學生自主學習的能力。停課期間,雖然學生缺乏實質校園環境的氣氛及朋輩推動的學習情境,但學校按學生不同的需要,規劃多元而全面的學習層次,設計不同類型的教學活動以推動學生在家學習。學校有序的安排得到家長的認同,認為老師按部就班地協助學生學習才能提升學習成效。

前言:

本 科深信每位學生的才能及學習方法各有不同,如果能照顧學生的學習多樣性,讓他們都能積極投入學習,相信在教與學上都可以事半功倍。因此,本科組於本學年參加了賽馬會的「校本多元」:「拓展選擇」計劃。此計劃項目由香港中文大學香港教育研究所優質學校改進計劃(QSIP)支援,發展及應用「適異教學法」(Differentiated Instruction),目標為照顧學生的多樣性,推動自主學習。

計劃特色:

校在「生活與社會科」實施校本課程,不採用教科書,自行編寫校本教材;我們透過共同備課商討課程規劃、分享教材及課業設計、交流教學策略的運用等,探討照顧學生學習多樣性的策略。

此外,本科另一特色是不設校內紙筆考試,這能讓科組有較大空間嘗試多元評估策略,老師可以根據同學的上課表現、課業、專題研習等計算成績。科組期望透過是次協作,發展有效照顧學習差異的校本課程及課業,並提升科組教師在課堂內照顧不同能力學生的教學技巧。

展望及總結:

村 據學生的課堂和課業表現,這學年的試驗頗為成功。 老師先在學期初進行問卷調查,了解同學對哪一種上課模式較感興趣、繼而計劃每一單元課題的輸入內容及教學活動。根據老師及學校發展主任的觀察、同學對本科所教授的課題甚感興趣,不同能力的學生均樂於參與課堂活動,亦漸漸建立預習及分組討論的習慣成常規。本科組會把本學年的成功教學策略作基礎、並於將來本科不同年級實踐及優化,更會於學校不同平台分享於其他科目,從而推動全校參與。

停課不停學 自主學習新機遇

議學生於停課期間持續有效學習·能夠「停課不停學」·學校將停課日期劃分成十一個學習階段·於校網及「eClass」統一發放各科電子學習資源·以讓學生能夠有系統地在家學習。而在這十一個學習階段中·學校基於三個多元而全面的學習層次安排學生學習。

這三個不同的學習層次分別為:

第一層 以溫故為主,老師於「eClass」派發功課,讓學生自行完成。

第二層 以知新為主,老師運用「Zoom」、「Keynote」、「Explain Everything」、「Screen Recording」、「AZ Screen Recorder」等軟件製作教學視頻或教學簡報,讓學生運用電子學習資源學習新知識,並要呈交課業至「Google Classroom」、「Schoology」等電子學習平台。

第三層以即時互動為主,老師運用網絡會議軟件「Zoom」進行網絡實時教學。

三月九日起,學校除推展第一層及第二層教學外,並全面推動第三層教學安排,中一至中六學生均運用網絡會議軟件「Zoom」參與網絡實時課堂。網絡實時課堂每節四十分鐘,初中學生平均每天上課兩至三節,而高中學生平均每天上課四節。網絡實時課堂有助學生於停課期間建立學習常規,並讓老師與學生在停課期間見面,保持互動,鞏固所學。

在 停課期間,學生均積極參與網絡實時課堂,並妥善運用老師提供的電子學習資源, 在 努力在家學習,做到停課而不停學,表現令人讚許。




WONG WANG HEI (Classmate)
